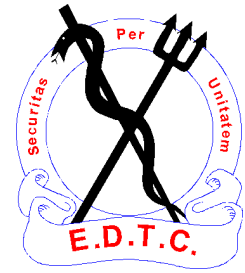

## Score table to determine the credits from the logged activities of MEDs

MEDs should log their activities in their logbook that we have designed for that purpose. Each activity with a value for CME should be noted with date and reference for review or verification. For each such activity the numerator in the column "Effective units" on the scoring table goes up by 1. At the end of the 3 to 5 years period (the proposed recertification period for which the score is calculated) the "Creditable score points" are calculated using the informations in the columns "Score points/unit" and "min/max score points" from the same table. The minimal score points needed for a recertification by the EDTC Certifying Board are shown in the text field below the table.

### Minimal scores for recertification as Medical Examiner of Divers (Level 1)

16 CME + 2 pract (+ ev. Options) = Total 18 score units (for period of 3 years\*; proportionally more if 4 or 5 years)

**Options:** Points from "Other activities" may replace missing points from CME (max. 50%) or/and pract (max 80%); literature credits can replace maximally 33%

\* according to national rules the interval may be 4 or 5 years. The score is to be appropriately adapted in such cases
